Ms. Rosen read a portion of a court case Counsel State College vs. Trenton State College. The court's decision: "Good practice would dictate that resolutions be as specific as possible". Litigation should read: Litigation – A vs. B.

Mayor Lachawiec requested Ms. Rosen leave the documentation with the Township Committee. The Township Committee will have the Township Attorney review it.

Township Attorney McGuckin will review the matter with the Township Clerk. Township Attorney McGuckin stated the contractual issue is a shared-services agreement, the litigation is the Gippenberg matter and the personnel matter is not going to be disclosed. There is also a contract regarding health benefits.

Ms. Rosen stated it is required that Executive Session minutes be adequate – not just headings. The minutes are intended to recite and disclose any official decision or action taken by the governing body.

Township Attorney McGuckin has reviewed the minutes and stated the Executive Session minutes Township Clerk Ambrosio has prepared over the last year are adequate and appropriate under the law.

Ms. Rosen stated Mr. McGuckin charged \$1,000 to redact information from the 2004 & 2005 Executive Session minutes, which have never been adopted. This \$1,000 could have been avoided if Ms. Rosen had been told the minutes are not available, as they have not been adopted.

Eileen Doyle, 243 11<sup>th</sup> Street, thanked Township Clerk Ambrosio for getting an alternate bus trip date, due to the holiday. Ms. Doyle stated the riders on the bus will do whatever it takes to get Oceanride to travel to the Ocean County Mall.
