WHEREAS, on Wednesday, January 4, 2012, pursuant to legal advertisements therefor, sealed bids were received for the Tuscarora Avenue water main replacement; and

WHEREAS, at the advertised time and place responses were received from the following bidders:

WHEREAS, after receipt and examination of said bids it was determined that the low bidder on said project was MSP Construction Corporation, 126 Walnut Street, Newark, New Jersey, in the bid amount of \$539,221.20; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be appropriate and in the best interests of the Township of Ocean to accept the low bid of MSP Construction Corporation to construct said water main replacement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

That MSP Construction Corporation be awarded the contract for construction of the subject project and that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MSP Construction Corporation, Newark, New Jersey, 08094, subject to availability of funds and approval of the NJEIT in accord with the letter of Wayne R. McVicar, P.E., P.P., C.M.E., dated January 5, 2012, accepting its bid in the amount of \$539,221.20 for the replacement of the water main on Tuscarora Avenue in accord with the bid submitted and the terms thereof as set forth in bid specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be made available to the Administrator, Director of Utilities, Engineer, Attorney, Auditor, NJEIT and MSP Construction Corporation, the successful bidder.
