Resolution authorizing the award of a state contract to L3 Mobile-Vision, Inc. Communications for the acquisition of a digital video system for the Township of Ocean Police Department

WHEREAS, the Township of Ocean employs a municipal police department who is charged the safety and well being of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Ocean furnished needed resources to the police department in order for departmental personnel to carry out their assigned law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, in order for the department to perform their police duties, the Township Committee approved bond ordinance number 2013-27 which allocated a total of \$250,000 in funding for the Ocean Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, out of the \$250,000 allocated a total of \$134,849.17 was earmarked for the acquisition of digital video system for the necessary law enforcement and emergency equipment so that the vehicle can be placed safely into service; and

THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED by the TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE of the TOWNSHIP of OCEAN, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, that the governing body hereby authorizes the purchase digital video system off of State Contract #A81311 from L3 Mobil-Vision Inc. total cost of \$134,849.17.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this expenditure for the acquisition of the fully equipped police patrol vehicles for the Ocean Township Police Department will be charged to the appropriate account of Bond Ordinance 2013-27.
