

Resolution 2014-182

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Ocean, Ocean County desires to apply for and obtain a Post-Sandy Planning Assistance grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA); and

WHEREAS, Township of Ocean, Ocean County has attended an orientation session held by DCA explaining the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Township of Ocean, Ocean County intends to apply for Post-Sandy Planning Assistance grant money for the following planning activities and in the following amounts:

1. Waterfront Zoning Update
\$20,000
2. Master Plan Reexamination Report and Update to the Master Plan
\$50,000
3. Update to Floodplain Management Plan and Ordinance
\$50,000
4. Permit Application Process Quality Improvement
\$25,000
5. Capital Improvement Plans
\$30,000
6. GIS Development
\$50,000

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of Township of Ocean, Ocean County does hereby authorize the application for the above grant(s); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Township of Ocean, Ocean County has sustained a ratable loss attributable to Super Storm Sandy of at least 1 percent or \$1 million dollars, as indicated by the attached documentation from the tax assessor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Township of Ocean, Ocean County recognizes and accepts that DCA may offer a lesser or greater amount of grant funding than that requested; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Township of Ocean, Ocean County authorizes the execution of the grant agreement in the amount offered and approved by DCA and further authorizes the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the grant agreement entered into by Township of Ocean, Ocean County and DCA; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Township of Ocean, Ocean County agrees to comply with all CDBG-DR regulations, Post Sandy Planning Assistance Guidelines and also accepts that the proposed use(s) of CDBG-DR funds are not reimbursable by FEMA, SBA or other federal agencies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the persons whose names appear below (or any successor or assign) are authorized to sign the grant agreement or any other document in connection therewith.
