

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CANCELLING CERTAIN FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES HERETOFORE PROVIDED FOR VARIOUS MUNICIPAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE TOWNSHIP TOTALING \$925,000, AND REAPPROPRIATING SUCH FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCE FOR VARIOUS MUNICIPAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND TO REAPPROPRIATE THE SUM \$925,000 OF TO PAY THE COST THEREFORE**

Be it ORDAINED and enacted by the Township Committee of Ocean, County of Ocean, state of New Jersey (not less than two thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), as follows:

**SECTION 1**

The following funded appropriation remaining as a balance in the bond ordinance heretofore adopted by the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, New Jersey ("Township") are hereby cancelled:

Amount -- \$925,000.00

**SECTION 2**

The aggregate sum of \$925,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the bond ordinance referred to in Section 1 for the following purposes:

**A. Recreation Improvements -- \$300,000**

Reconstruction and rehabilitation of municipal recreation facilities, including but not limited to tennis courts, basketball courts, athletic fields and playground.

**B. Police Vehicles and Equipment -- \$150,000**

Providing for the purchase of three (3) all-wheel drive SUV type of law enforcement vehicles for the Ocean Township Police Department along with necessary communication, information technology, emergency lighting, prisoner transport equipment and all other items needed to place the SUV type of vehicle into proper and safe service.

**C. Public Works Equipment -- \$150,000**

Acquisition on one (1) large dump truck

**D. Storm water Management Improvement -- \$100,000**

Providing for the community wide enhancement, upgrading and expansion of the municipal storm management or drainage system based on ongoing study and recommendation of the township engineer.

**D. Police Communication Equipment -- \$50,000**

Providing for the purchase and installation of a police recording system along with the acquisition of other needed communication equipment required by the Ocean Township Police Department.

**E. Rehabilitation of Municipal Fleet -- \$50,000**

Providing for the rehabilitation, restoration, modernization and enhancement of high valued municipal vehicles and equipment.

**F. Municipal Facilities and Public Buildings Improvement Work -- \$50,000**

Providing for the enhancement, upgrading and modernization of municipal facilities and public buildings.

**G. Safety Equipment -- \$50,000**

Acquisition of mandated safety equipment for the municipal workforce and first responders including equipment needed to comply with various and numerous state and federal health and safety laws and regulations.

**H. Information Technology -- \$25,000**

Acquisition of needed information technology hardware and software required to maintain, enhance and update the municipal technology infrastructure in order to maintain certain work efficiencies along with safeguarding municipal technology related systems.

### **SECTION 3**

The period of usefulness of said purpose, within the limitation of the Local Bond Law and according to reasonable life thereof computed from the date of said bonds authorized by this ordinance, is not less than five (5) years.

### **SECTION 4**

The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the municipal clerk and available for inspection during business hours.

### **SECTION 5**

The improvements authorized are not current expenses and are general improvements that the Township may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

### **SECTION 6**

This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

### **CERTIFICATION**

The ordinance was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Ocean, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, held on August 14, 2014. It was further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body held in the Municipal Building, in the Township on September 11, 2014 at 6:30 P.M., and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerks' office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Ocean, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, on July 12, 2012. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 50 Railroad Avenue, Waretown, New Jersey on November 13, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:
