

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, in the aftermath of the October 29, 2012 Superstorm Sandy event, the Governing Body and the Planning Board of the Township of Ocean have determined that it is appropriate to prepare a Floodplain Management Plan to be incorporated as an element of the Township of Ocean's Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the planning process was conducted through a Steering Committee consisting of members of the public and Township employees and officials to work with the Borough and Planning Board professionals, including Patrick J. Jeffery, P.E., P.P., C.M.E., Stanley Slachetka, P.P. AICP, Martin Truscott, P.P., AICP, and James M. Oris, P.E., P.P., CME to prepare the plan in accordance with the requirements outlined in the National Flood Insurance Program Community Rating System Coordinator's Manual; and

WHEREAS, the Floodplain Management Plan provides an identification and assessment of flood hazards and impacts within the Township, establishes goals and objectives for floodplain management and resiliency, and presents a series of actions and measures to minimize flooding and mitigate the impacts from flooding in the future; and

WHEREAS, a number of public meetings have been held over the last several months to discuss the proposed plan, and the Planning Board of the Township of Ocean adopted the Floodplain Management Plan on May 7, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Township of Ocean, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2015 that the Governing Body supports the decision of the Planning Board and adopts the 2015 Floodplain Management Plan, dated April 2015.
