

**ORDINANCE NO. 2016-4**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 61-3 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION I.** Chapter 61-3 of the Township Code, entitled "Composition" of the Ocean Township Police Department is amended to include new provisions thereof to be designated as follows:

- C. Any and all promotions within the Township's Police Department, as referenced above, shall be made within six (6) months after the completion of interviews by the appropriate authority and highest ranking officer within the department. In the event promotions have not been made within six (6) months of the conclusion of the last interview conducted by the appropriate authority and highest ranking police officer within the department, then and in that event, before any of said promotions shall take place, a new interview process shall be completed.
- D. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Subsection (61-3) interviews for the position of Chief of Police shall be conducted solely by the Township Committee.

**SECTION II.** Any section, subsection, clause, phrase, ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION III.** This Ordinance shall take affect after second reading and publication as required by law.
