

RESOLUTION 2016- 272

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY OPPOSING JERSEY CENTRAL POWER &  
LIGHT (JCP&L) RATE INCREASE.**

**WHEREAS**, Jersey Central Power and Light (JCP&L) serves more than a million customers in New Jersey, extending across Ocean and Monmouth counties, as well as parts of Burlington, Essex, Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Morris, Passaic, Somerset, Sussex, Union, and Warren Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, Jersey Central Power and Light wants to raise rates; and

**WHEREAS**, a rate increase could force seniors on fixed incomes and families struggling to get by to choose between keeping their lights on, heating their homes, putting food on the table or buying needed medication; and

**WHEREAS**, the consequence of such an increase would also adversely affect small business owners, many of whom are just now beginning to recover from the destruction of Superstorm Sandy; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the opinion of this Board that the Company's return of investments should fund the improvements necessary and that a dedicated fund should be established to finance improvements thus eliminating the need to propose huge rate-hikes for their customers; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposal by Jersey Central Power and Light must still undergo regulatory hearings before an administrative law judge and be approved by the State Board of Public Utilities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey hereby urges that prior to the approval of any rate increase strong consideration be given to the devastating effect such an increase would have on senior citizens, struggling families and the business community.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Township Committee of the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey opposes any such rate hike.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that certified copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to Members of the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 30<sup>th</sup> Legislative Districts, the Board of Public Utilities and all Ocean County Municipalities.
