**WHEREAS**, in the event of a large scale emergency, natural disaster, pandemic, or terrorist attack, it is America’s civic responsibility to be prepared; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ocean County Office of Emergency Management and the Ocean County Board of Health, recognizes the need to increase public awareness about the importance of emergency and public health preparedness in Ocean County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ocean County Board of Health and the Ocean County Medical Reserve Corp is therefore actively participating this September in National Preparedness Month conducting outreach activities urging Ocean County residents to:

- Be informed about the different types of Public Health emergencies that could occur in Ocean County and their appropriate responses
- Build a family preparedness kit for disasters
- Make a Plan: Prepare plan and stay informed for emergencies
- Get Involved: Find opportunities to support community preparedness
- Business: Plan for and protect business
