RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE OCEAN COUNTY PROSECUTORS OFFICE AND THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN WITH THE OCEAN COUNTY PROSECUTORS OFFICE ACTING AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR ACCESS TO THE AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION (ALPR) SERVER IN ORDER TO OBTAIN LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION DATA

WHEREAS, pursuant to NJSA 40:65A et seq., the Township of Ocean has agreed to enter into Shared Service Agreements for access to the Ocean County Prosecutors Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) server in order to obtain License Plate Recognition information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township Committee and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute Shared Service Agreements with each of the abovementioned agencies in accordance with the provisions of law.
2. The Ocean County Prosecutor's Office operates an Automated License Plate Recognition (ALPR) server. This system has the ability to link other ALPR's within the County with this server and update them with the databases provided by the State of New Jersey. The Ocean County Prosecutor's Office recognizes the need to maintain interoperability with local, county and federal law enforcement agencies, within Ocean County and has offered to host other participating agencies to utilize the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office ALPR system server.
3. The Lead Agency shall provide access to the server via a Virtual Private Network connection to the Participating Agency, at no cost from the date of this agreement.
4. This agreement is in effect until terminated by either the Lead Agency or the Participating Agency. This agreement is "at will" and can be terminated by either the Lead Agency or the Participating Agency without notice. Upon termination of this agreement the Participating Agency shall have their access to the system immediately disabled. Should the Participating Agency access be terminated by the New Jersey State Police for non-compliance, access to the ALPR server will be immediately disabled.
5. A copy of the agreements referenced herein shall be kept on file and made available for public inspection at the Municipal Clerk's office during normal business hours.
