Sunday July 21, 2019 1-3 PM

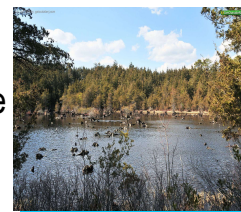

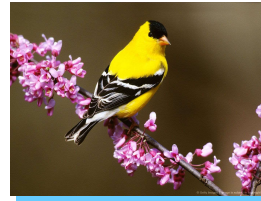
